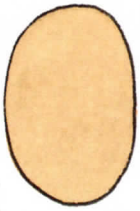
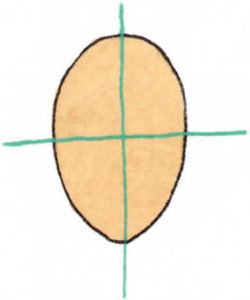


FACE IT!

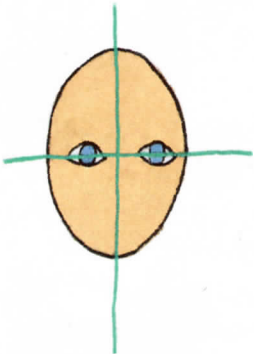
For easy-as-pie faces, make a grid on a head to show you where to put the eyes, ears, nose, and mouth. After you've done it a few times, you won't need the grid.



- ① Start with an oval.

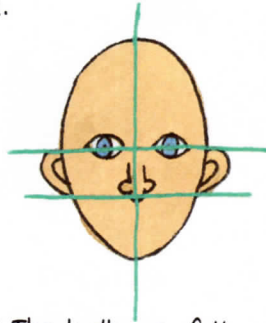


- ② Draw a horizontal line halfway up the oval, and another line right down the middle.

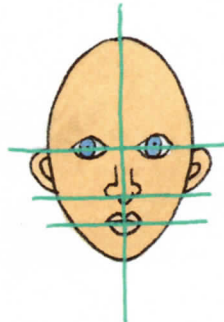


- ③ The eyes go on the horizontal line.

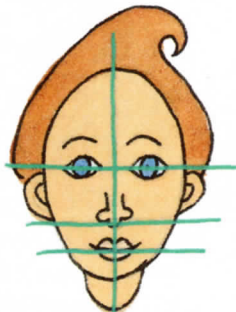

- ④ The bottoms of the nose and ears go halfway between the eyes and chin.



- ⑤ The mouth goes halfway between the nose and chin.

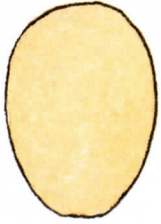


- ⑥ Now add hair, eyebrows, and a neck!

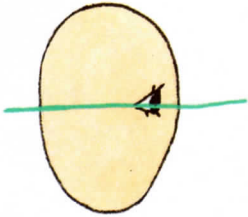
SIDE STEPS

The grid is the same for a side view of a head.

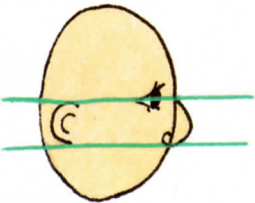

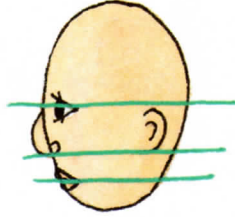
- ① Start with an oval.



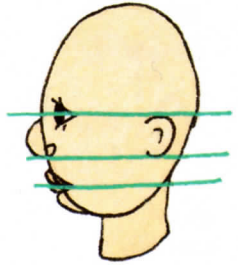
- ② Draw the eye halfway down. It looks like a sideways V.



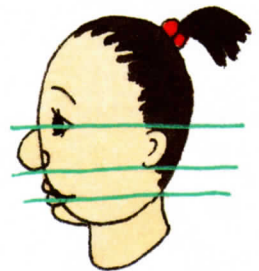
- ③ The bottoms of the nose and ear go halfway between the eye and chin.



- ④ The mouth is halfway between the nose and chin. You can make it like a heart lying on its side.



- ⑤ Now add the neck and make the chin a little bigger.



- ⑥ Finish with the hair, eyebrow, and an earring if you want.
